Fauda	Israel	Netflix	A retired Israeli undercover agent gets recruited by his old squad for "one more job" catching a terrorist in Palestine who was presumed dead.	Prepare for hair-raising action and stomach clenching tension. Created by a real Israeli agent (who also stars in the show). This show has been lauded for presenting both sides of the story, as we see the events from the Palestinian point of view as well as the Israelis'. I felt it gave me a deeper understanding of the daily situation over there, even if it is dramatized. Season 2 gets a little silly.
Trapped	Iceland	Amazon	In a small Icelandic town, a ferry carrying 300 passengers from Denmark is trapped at the dock by a horrible blizzard. Meanwhile, a dismembered body washes onshore, leading detectives to believe a murder occurred on board the ship. The detectives must solve the mystery during the storm, before the weather clears and the ship leaves.	Olafur Darri Olafsson! In the US, he usually plays creepy guys, but in this show he is a lovable bear of a detective. Also, the weather. It really adds a unique element to the show. And it's not faked-it took them 6 months to shoot because they had to wait for blizzardy weather in order to film each day.
Spiral	France	Netflix	Police procedural and legal drama following six members of the judicial system in Paris-3 cops, 2 prosecutors and 1 judge. Each season follows one crime story, and a long arc develops for the main characters over 7 seasons.	One of my favorites. It's gritty and the characters are all flawed but still likable. Bonus-you really learn a LOT about the French criminal system-cases are assigned a prosecutor and judge while they are still being investigated, forcing the police into an uneasy working relationship with the judicial system.
Dark	Germany	Netflix	The disappearance of two teens triggers an investigation that opens up three generations of dark secrets in a small town in Germany. The series follows four families whose lives are interconnected in all three generations.	This synopsis may not sound interesting, but this is an intriguing show with a major twist, and saying any more in the synopsis would give it away. Dark was the first German show that Netflix bought and it was very popular here and in its native Germany.

At the same time, there is a series of murders that resemble those of a serial killer in the past.	This is the original French version of "The Returned". The Rain	Denmark	Netflix	A Father rushes his family into a sophisticated hidden bunker to avoid a toxic rain that's coming. Then he leaves them behind. 8 years later, with no food and little oxygen left, the siblings are forced to emerge from the bunker to survive outside.	Not really crime. Fun concept.
